#### How Much Noise Is Too Much Noise?

Noise exposures add up throughout events and daily activity. Hearing loss can result from damage to structures or nerve fibers in the inner ear that respond to sound. Certain behaviors, events, and environmental factors are all contributors. A few examples of noise exposure that can result in hearing loss would be rock concerts, portable media devices at high volume levels, construction work and even athletic events.

## Signs and Symptoms of Hearing Loss

Because the damage from noise exposure is usually gradual, a person might not notice or might ignore signs of hearing loss until more pronounced symptoms of permanent hearing loss become evident. Family, coworkers and friends are typically the first to notice these symptoms. Noticeable signs of hearing loss can include the following:

- Muffled or distorted hearing
- Difficulty hearing sounds such as birds singing, crickets chirping, alarm clock, telephones or doorbells
- Difficulty understanding speech during telephone conversations or participating in group conversations
- Pain or ringing in the ears after exposure to excessively loud sounds
